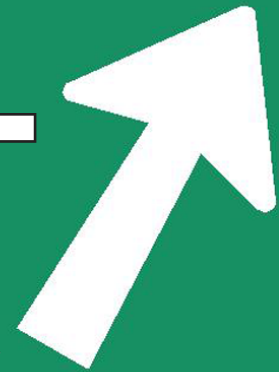

PANEL moderated by Dr. Thomas Wolfe, Dean of Hendricks Chapel:

Jimmy Massey is a 12-year veteran of the U.S. Marine Corps and one of the first non-commissioned military officers to report human rights abuses in Iraq. He is a leading pro-soldier, anti-war activist and a founding member of Iraq Veterans Against the War.

Dr. Dahlia Wasfi spent her early childhood in Saddam Hussein's Iraq. Based on her experiences, she is speaking out against the negative impact of the U.S. invasion on the Iraqi people and the need to end the occupation.

Scott Ritter was a chief United Nations weapons inspector in Iraq from 1991 to 1998. Prior to the US invasion of Iraq, Ritter argued that Iraq possessed no significant weapons of mass destruction (WMDs).
