Dear Friend of Peace:

The fact that your name is on our mailing list shows that our activities mean something to you.

During the past six weeks we have provided speakers for more than fifty organized groups in the Syracuse area, reaching a total of 2,810 people. We are enclosing a statement of other activities of the Council for the year.

In our everyday business we are outspoken and very frank in regard to financial matters. Therefore, we are coming to you with our immediate problem. We need \$250 before June 20, in order to close the season without a deficit.

Ask yourself these questions: (1) Are we worth paying for? (2) Do you want us to keep going?

The activities of the Council are dependent on the small contributions of large numbers of peace-lovers rather than on large gifts from a few. Some people give until it hurts; others have to be hurt before they will give. The cause of peace needs you NOW.

Your gift, though modest, will be our signal to continue. We await that gift.
